Daniel was a Private in the Revolutionary War, NC Militia company commanded by Capt Little in Regt commanded by Col Hill, from Martin County. He served for 8 months.He fought at the battle of Guilford Court House. His pension voucher #12867. Certificate filed 6 June 1833 with arrears to 4 March 1833, recorded Book E, Vol 6, page 54. He also had two brothers that served in the Revolutionary War. James and Henry Jr. Robason.

Per a sworn statement by Elizabeth his wife, Daniel died on the 9th of August 1835 in Martin County, North Carolina. However, prior to his death it is probable that Daniel purchased property in Haywood County, Tennessee. Taken from haywood County, Tennessee Deek Book H, page 232- - October 4, 1834. On January 28, 1833, Daniel Cherry had bought 100 acres from Washington R. Blackard. then he sold it back to Blackard; Blackard did not have the deed registered, but sold the land to Daniel Roberson on October 4, 1834 for \$400.00 Daniel Cherry here giving a good title to Roberson.

Birth, death and marriage records for this family comes from the family Bible which was found included in the Revolutionary War Pension papers.

Elizabeth Griffin is the daughter of John Griffin. She was born Bet. 1759–1761 in North Carolina. She died Aft. 04 Oct 1850 in Haywood County, Tennessee.

Notes for Elizabeth Griffin:

General Notes:

Elizabeth is last seen living with her son Bryant Robeson and his family in the 1850 District 12, Haywood County Tennessee census. She is 91 years old born in North Carolina. Her birth year from her husband's pension papers indicates that she was born in 1761, this census records give 1759. There are letters in the pension papers from Haywood County, Tennessee to the pension board dated 1848. It is believed that she moved to Haywood County Tennessee with her sons somewhere after the death of her husband in 1835 but before 1840. Elizabeth drew her last widow's pension voucher (\$26.64) 23 January 1849. Since she did not receive another pension voucher, it is assumed she died soon after the 1850 census. There is no record of her death/burial in Haywood County, Tennessee.

I Jasper Robason of the County of Beaufort and State of North Carolina being vary sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all Imen once to dye do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principaly and first of all I give and Recommend my soul into the hand of God that give it and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christain burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but it general resurrection. I shall receive the salm again by the mighty Power of God and as touching such wordly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to biefs me in this life. I give & dispose of the same in the following manner and form. I give and bequeath to Absillea my dearly beloved wife all my lands and tennaments with all my Household goods debts and moveable Effects by her freely to be poffeffed and enjoyed. Except my horse, bridle and saddle and Chart? to be sold by my Executors to be desposed of for the use of paying such debts Claims and demands as Shall be proper and also I leave in the like manner my gun and all my carpainders and coopers tools to be sld: at her death or marriage, I give to my son Noah all my lands and all the rest of my property to be equaly devided between my daughters Harriet, Charlot, Penny and Christeny; and I hereby ordain my beloved wife Absilea and Thomas Walker Execuors of this my last will and testament in witnefs where of I the said Jasper Robason have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal.
