



Allie Campbell

Allie Campbell was born about 1853 in Warren County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Robert A Campbell (1814-?) and Sarah Ann Harrison (1823-?). Her brother, Edward Campbell (1843) was Circuit Court clerk for the Middle Tennessee District.

By 1860 Robert Campbell had died. Sarah and her children had moved to or near downtown McMinnville, their address being "Post Office" McMinnville. Sarah's mother, Judith C (Turner) Harrison (1803-?) was also living with them.

Sarah and Robert's children were: Edward (1843), James W (1846), Charles (1848) and Almira "Allie" (1853).

Allie's uncle, Horace H Harrison (1829), was a friend of Gates P Thruston, the noted archeologist who was the authority of Tennessee antiquities. In 1873 he sent Horace Harrison to the Middle East, including Egypt, Syria and Turkey.

Allie Campbell and her mother, Sarah Ann were interred next each other at D T Puckett cemetery. Later they were disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at their disinterment.
