



Amy Murdock

Amy Murdock was born in 1839 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Her date of death is unknown. She was a daughter of Samuel Murdock (1812- ?) and Mary A Puckett (1811-1884). Mary Puckett was born in White County, Tennessee and died in Missouri.

Amy Murdock and two of her sisters were born “deaf and dumb.” In 1854 Amy, Malinda and Luceta were admitted to the Tennessee School for the Deaf in Knoxville, Tennessee.

Samuel Murdock and Mary had quite a large family. Their children were: Nancy (1835), Mary (1837), Malinda (1839), Amy (1839), Lucetta (1843), George (1844), Dianna (1846) and Daniel (1849).

Amy, Malinda, and Lucetta returned home after graduating from Tennessee School for the Deaf, and Amy and Malinda remained unmarried. Lucetta did marry.

Amy Murdock was buried at D T Puckett cemetery, and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was recorded as being present at her disinterment.
