

Arthur Lafever

Arthur LaFever was born August 11, 1919 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died in July, 1920 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a twin, his brother being Luther LaFever (1919-1971). He was a son of William Jesse LaFever (1880-1950) and Sarah Elizabeth Gay (1882-1956).

William and Sarah had three sets of twins, and a total of 15 children. Eleven of them reached maturity, an amazing feat in those days.

Luther had a cleft palate and could not breast feed, but Sarah saved him by feeding him mashed beans. Arthur died at 11 months with a stomach virus.

Arthur was buried at D T Puckett cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly. There is no record of anyone being present at his disinterment.
