Arwine Peyton Page was born January 18, 1873 and died January 2, 1951. He was born and died in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of Arwine E Page (1837-1907) and Amanda A Trapp (1837-1904).

He married Mary Josie Anderson on August 14, 1892 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was born July 18, 1872 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died March 6, 1934 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Calvin Anderson (1850-1918) and Margaret A Adcock (1853-1910).

Arwine and Josie reared a large family: Willie M (1894), Nora L (1896), Allie Ocie (1897), Charles Haskel (1901), Amanda E (1903), Janes C (1905), Altie Helen (1907), Alton P (1907) and Pearl J (1910.
