

Elizabeth Ann "Betsie" White

Elizabeth Ann White was born around 1830 and died in 1850 and was supposedly the daughter of James White (abt. 1797 NC- Dec. 1859 DeKalb, TN) and Mary English (abt. 1797 NC- after 1860 census), according to the book "On the Taylor Trail".

She married in about 1848 David C "Shakerhead" Taylor, and died two years later. They had one child, William E. Taylor (born ca.1849-died ca. 1883). W.E. married Nancy Melinda Fish (born ca. 1850-died ca. 1886) on Aug. 22, 1867 in DeKalb Co. TN. Both born in DeKalb Co. TN & both died in McMinnville, TN.

Five years later, in 1855, David C Taylor married Betsie Ann's sister, Evelina.

The monument above has David C Taylor's two wives carved on opposite sides.

Betsie Ann Taylor was disinterred from Claud Walker cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. A step-grandson, H S Taylor was present at the removal.
