

Callie Tittsworth

Hannah Callie Tittsworth was born February 26, 1883 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died March 14, 1902. She was the last child of eleven born to Richard Murrell Tittsworth (1835-1863) and Mary E Johnson (1843-1888) also of Dekalb County.

Since she lived only 19 years she did not marry. Her siblings were Levina (1863), Martha (1865), Elisah (1867), Joseph (1869), William (1871), Nancy (1873), Robert (1875) John (1875), Lemuel (1876), Ephraim (1877) and then Callie.

Richard Murrell Tittsworth was the son of Richard Miles Tittsworth (1804-?) and Lucetta (1805-?). He married Mary E Johnson, a daughter of Joseph Johnson (1812-1865?) and Lavina Boyd (1812-about 1885). They married March 3, 1861 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.

When Callie died she was buried at Mildred Corley cemetery, and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.
