

Captain John Pack

John Pack, L. L. Dearman, 1st Co. "I", 35th Tenneseee Infantry Regiment. Disbanded April 1862 and men transferred to other companies. men from DeKalb County. The 35th regiment trained at Camp Smartt in Warren County, Tennessee.

John Pack was born about 1816 in Warren County, Tennessee and died November 18, 1862, said to have died in the Civil War. He was a son of Bartemus Pack (1795-1874) and Mary Bain (1796-?).

John Pack married Maria Hayes in 1836. She was born in 1817 and died in 1856. Both John and Maria were born in Warren County, Tennessee. Maria Hayes was the daughter of Isaac Hayes (1767-1836) and Margaret (1799-1860).

They had children: William Matthew (1838), Mary J (1841), Margaret E (1843), Bartemus Hayes (1845), James Monroe (1848), Assenith Mariah (1850), Bethena Francis (1854) and John Weddington (1856).

Captain Pack was buried at Heirs of Martha Pack Cemetery and was later relocated to Mt Holly Cemetery. No one was listed as present at his disinterment.
