



Charlie Carter

Charlie Carter was born July 17, 1898 and died November 17, 1922 in Akron, OH. He was a son of William A "Billy" Carter (1866-1944) and Marguerite E Givens (1874-1937). His Summit Co., OH death certificate lists his parents as "W A Carter" and "Maggie Giffins". He was a rubber worker in Ohio.

He married February 2, 1918 in Putnam County, Tennessee, Miss Nancy D Herald. She was born in 1902 in Putnam County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of William V Herald (1866-?) and Mary Frances "Fannie" Glover (1869-?).

Charlie's WWI Draft Registration Card gives his birthdate as July 17, 1897, a year earlier than the date given on the census. Charlie declares he is a farmer at Silver Point, and gives his wife's name as Nancy.

Charlie Carter was interred at Moss Generation Cemetery, and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. His father William A Carter was present at the disinterment.
