



Charlie Clemons

Charlie Clemons was born March 13, 1878 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died November 27, 1954. He was the son of John Clemons (1810-1910+) and Martha Ann Glover (1840-?).

On December 23, 1908 he married Minnie Mirtle Clemons in Putnam County, Tennessee. She was born May 18, 1892 and died June 6, 1974. Her parents were George Edwin Clemons and Martha L Maggard.

According to Charlie's WWI Draft registration card Charlie was blind in his right eye. He also stated he was a resident of Silver Point, Tennessee, and was married to Minnie Clemons.

Their children were: Masie (1909), Cora (1912), Woodrow (1917) Escol (1919), Irene (1920), Maggie (1927), Vinnie (1928) and Marion (1930).

Sometime before 1942 the family moved to Deedsville, Indiana where Charlie farmed for Merritt Fishburn. He was 64 years old and filled out a registration for the draft in Peru, Indiana. Minnie died there in June of 1974.

Charlie died in 1954, 20 years before Minnie. He is interred at Mt Holly Cemetery.
