

**Christopher Ervin** 

Christopher C Ervin was born about 1816 in Smith County, Tennessee and died after 1892. His parents are presently unknown.

On August 6, 1838 he married in Smith County, Tennessee Sarah A Nichol. She was born about 1817.

They had these children: Mary Watts (1837), James (1839), Amanda V (1842), Elizabeth (1844), William (1844) and Joshua (1846).

Sarah Nichol apparently died before 1850, as Christopher was remarried that year to Sarah L Watts. She was born in November 1828 in Jackson County, Tennessee and died in 1913 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Christopher and Sarah were married about 1850 in Smith County, Tennessee. Sarah's father was Mason Bennett Watts (1795-?) and her mother was Mary B Clemons (1795-?).

Christopher and Sarah Watts had these children: Thomas C (1851), Robert Eli (1854), Laura F (1856), Martha Canzatie (1860), John J (1861), George Washington (1863), Elec (1866), Bettie F (1869) and Susan (1871.

Christopher Ervin was buried in Mildred Corley Cemetery and was later disinterred and removed to Mt Holly Cemetery. A son, Elec Erwin was present at his disinterment.
