

Daisy Ella (Eastham) Dyer

Daisy Ella Dyer was born January 24, 1886 at Falling Waters in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died February 16, 1956 in Smithville, Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Henry Eastham (1837-1923) and Nancy Emma Cantrell (1859-?).

On August 26, 1906 she married William Fuson Dyer in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was born August 22, 1880 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died January 5, 1951 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of John Henry Dyer (1856-1889) and Elisabeth Steele (1857-1898). On his WWI registration card he said he was born at Silver Point in Putnam County, Tennessee. The 1910, 1920 and 1930 Federal censuses record them as living in Putnam County, Tennessee.

Daisy and William Dyer had five known children, beginning with Henry (1908), Helen (1915), Jack (1914), William F Jr (1918) and Gamaliel (1921), all born in Putnam County, Tennessee.

Daisy E Dyer is buried at Mt Holly cemetery. Her original interment location is not certain. When she was reinterred at Mt Holly noone was present.
