



Dr Samuel Walker

Dr Samuel H Walker was born February 8, 1848 in Warren County, Tennessee and died February 3, 1899. His father, Hampton Walker (1811-1886) was also from Warren County, as was his mother, Mary Hicks (1813-?).

In 1860 he lived at Tucker's Crossroads in Wilson County, Tennessee. On February 8, 1880 he married Sarah Hatton Glenn (1861-?) in Dekalb County, Tennessee. On the 1880 Federal Census his occupation is given as "Physician." He is said to have attended medical colleges in both Missouri and Iowa.

They had a large family. There were sisters Laura, Mary Jane, Nalma, and Martha. Their sons were Claude, Garrett, Samuel Roscoe, Sterling, Clarence, and John.
