



Drusilla Taylor

Drusilla Taylor was born September 8, 1887 and died September 4, 1888 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Elijah Taylor (1858-?) by his first wife, Parlee Robinson (1861-1889). Elijah and Parlee married August 6, 1882 in Dekalb County.

It was a sad time in 1888 -1889. Their first born child, Lula Taylor (1883-1888) died in 1888, and Drusilla died a few months later of the same year. Parlee lived exactly one year more after Drusilla died, passing September 4, 1889 in Dekalb County.

Elijah married again on August 9, 1892 Nancy J Turner and they had seven children.

“Gone so soon” said Drusilla's stone.

She was disinterred from Ed Taylor cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was present for her disinterment.
