



Daniel Edmond and Rebecca Ann “Becky” (Trapp) Judkins

Daniel Edmond (or sometimes spelled "Edward") Judkins was born on June 10, 1850 and died June 22, 1933 in Watertown, Wilson Co., TN. He was the son of Edmond B [or D?] Judkins (1805-1850) of Surry County, Virginia and Zilpha Rice (1806-after 1880) of North Carolina.

On December 13, 1868 he married Rebecca Trapp in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was born on May 4, 1849 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died on July 23, 1924 at Temperance Hall, Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Job Trapp (about 1809-about 1884) of Holmes Creek, Dekalb County, Tennessee and Mary Ann McGinnis (1811-1884).

Ed and Becky reared a large family. Their children were: Samantha (1869), J R (1871), Susan (1872), James (1873), William (1874), T S (1875), Benjamin (1876), Edward (1876), George (1887), D W (1884), Mary (1886), Elzy (1886), Roy (1889), Mandy (1889), Rosco (1891) and Shelton (1894).

The database states that when Ed and Becky were disinterred from W J Nixon cemetery they were relocated at Judkins cemetery. This must be incorrect as their monument is at Mt Holly cemetery. Also, Rebecca's death certificate states she was originally buried at "Prichard Cemetery". Ed's death certificate just states buried in DeKalb Co. Their son William M Judkins was present at the disinterment.
