

Elbert Taylor

Elbert Taylor lived his short life afflicted with epilepsy. He lived from May 8, 1875 – June 29, 1906. "To him we trust a place is given, among the saints with Christ in heaven."

He was born in Dekalb County, Tennessee, a son of Pleasant Green Taylor and Mary Drewery. If he and Albert are the same person there is a marker for Albert and a tombstone for Elbert.

The Liberty Herald mentions him as Elbert when they mentioned his epileptic condition. "Our Brother" is carved at the top of the stone. His brother Charlie D. (September 10, 1872—August 20, 1962, and his sister Amanda (January 4, 1859—) surely knew how his name was spelled.

When Elbert Taylor was disinterred from Ed Taylor cemetery for removal to Mt Holly his brother Charlie D Taylor was present.
