



Elizabeth Ferrell

Elizabeth Ferrell was born in White County, Tennessee, - but there is not much agreement on her birth date. The 1860 Federal census says “abt 1820,” but some researchers claim it to be December 18, 1811. Her stone claims her birth date to be either 1820 or 1826; it is difficult to read after so many years of weathering in the damp atmosphere of Center Hill Lake.

She died in Dekalb County, Tennessee about 1891. Her husband, Moses Pedigo, was a few years older than Elizabeth, having been born in 1785 in Henry County, Virginia. He died February 10, 1864.

Moses Pedigo was the son of Robert Henry Pedigo, Sr and Mary Phoebe Elkins. Elizabeth's parents are unknown. They left many descendants, having had at least eight children. The boys were: Josiah Jacob (1833), Greenberry Washington (1837), William Harvey (1845), and Alexander James (1845).

The girls were: Eliza Jane (1835), Martha Ann (1842), Catherine Elizabeth (1850), and Mary Ann (1854).

She was disinterred from C A Pedigo cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was present at the disinterment.
