

**Elsie Haynes Lowhorn** 

Elsie Haynes married Benton Lowhorn August 6, 1909, in Smith County, Tennessee. She was born August 10, 1881 in Tennessee and died March 31, 1928. Benton declared on his WWI Registration card that he was born September 21, 1890; his Social Security Death Index says September 20, 1889. He died in March 1955. He states he was born in Birdstown, Tennessee.

Together they raised at least six children: Hugh Lee (1911), Robert (1912), Otis (1917), Lucille (1920) Irean (1920), and Inez (1923).

When Elsie died in March, 1928 Benton didn't waste time; he married Allie Pitts on October 7 of the same year.

## Her headstone reads:

"She was a kind and affectionate wife, a fond mother, and a friend to all."

She was disinterred from Claud Walker cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly. Herschel Haynes was present at the disinterment.
