



Evelina (White) Taylor

“Her children rise up and call her blessed.”

Evelina White was born December 10, 1819, and died October 20, 1876 and was supposedly the daughter of James White (abt. 1797 NC- Dec. 1859 DeKalb, TN) and Mary English (abt. 1797 NC- after 1860 census), according to the book "On the Taylor Trail".

She was the second wife of David C “Shakerhead” Taylor (1823-1877). They married March 22, 1855. His first wife was Evelina's sister Elizabeth (Betsy Ann) White (1830-1850), whose name appears on the opposite side of the headstone.

David Taylor was the son of David Sr. (NC 1779-1854 DeKalb, TN) and Mary Watson (1780-?). He was born January 2, 1823 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died September 12, 1877.

Evelina and David had two sons; Harvey C Taylor (1856), and Horace Taylor (1858-1881).

Evelina Taylor was disinterred from Claud Walker cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly. Her grandson Horace S Taylor was present at the disinterment.
