



Frances Melvina (McClellan) Coggin

Frances Melvina McClellan was born November 29, 1836 and died January 13, 1900. Her parents were William McClellan (1810-1866) and Elizabeth Weisner (1800-1877).

On March 12, 1862 she married Eli Arnold Coggin. He was born December 30, 1824 and died April 11, 1886. Frances McClellan was his second wife, he having been married previously to Sarah A Coggin.

Together Frances and Eli had nine children: the girls were Mary Hester, Lethe Parilee, Martha Roxanna, Louisa Marinda, Fannie C, and Narcella Ella. There were three boys, Eli Caswell, Harvey Wesner, and James Edward.

Frances' monument bears these words: Since thou can no longer stay, To cheer me with thy love

I hope to kneel with thee again, In yon bright world above.

Frances Melvina Coggin was removed from K C Tramel cemetery and relocated at Mt Holly.
