

George Henley (died 1904) was a son of Farris Whitson Henley (August 5, 1875-May 14, 1966 Putnam Co., TN) and Mary Hayes (May 1880-1904). Farris and Mary married April 26, 1896 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Farris Henley was a son of Ammon D Henly (1848-?) and Malinda Herren (1846-?).

George is never mentioned on any of the censuses since he was born between 1900 and 1910. But proof of his existence is located on his burial and disinterment report. He is stated as George Henley, son of F W (Farris Whitson) Henley, who was present at Puckett cemetery when he was disinterred. The same report states that Mary (Hayes) Henley, his mother and Farris 1st wife, died in 1904 also. Farris Henley was also present at Mary's disinterment and is identified as Mary's husband.

Mary may have died in childbirth, as she died the same year as her son George, or perhaps they died of one of the many dread diseases that seemed to hit Silver Point especially hard.

Mary Henley and her son George were buried at Puckett cemetery, and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Farris Whitson Henley was present at their disinterment.
