



George Hiram Foster

George Hiram Foster was born September 9, 1878 and died September 18, 1933. He was a son of Wadkins Lee Foster (1832-1920) and Susan Prudence Alsup (1841-1925) both of Dekalb County, Tennessee.

On July 15, 1905 George married Norma Lavada Crawford, born September 11, 1883 and died March 2, 1944, a daughter of Knox Crawford (1848-?) and Nicey Ann Cytha Smith (?-1889).

George and Norma had a daughter they named Mourning Jewel (1907), as beautiful a name as the country from which she came. They also had a daughter Susan (1901) and a son Floyd (1912). Infant twins also were born and died in 1909.

George and Norma were interred at Moss Generation Cemetery, and were later relocated to Mt Holly Cemetery. Present at the disinterment was Mourning Jewel who was now Mrs Jewel Walker.
