



George Washington Vanhooser

George Washington Vanhooser was born February 23, 1911 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died January 17, 1912 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of William Carroll Vanhooser (1860-1920) of Warren County, Tennessee and Mary Elizabeth Cantrell (1869-1948).

His siblings were: John B (1888), James Stanton (1890), Nancy E (1893), Clara Lou (1900) and William Herman (1900).

George was the final child. When he died in 1912 he was buried at Helen F Conger cemetery with his father. He was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. His mother, who had remarried after William Carrolls death, was now Mrs L P Womack. She was present at the disinterment.
