



Hershal Arnold

Sometimes it's a guess. This is one of those times. Most researchers believe Hershal Arnold was a son of Thomas C Arnold (1880-?) and Dora Bell Pack (1879-1913). It seems more probable that he is the son of Thomas Jefferson Arnold (1880-1970) and Vivian Arnold (maiden name unknown) (1879-?).

When Thomas Jefferson Arnold signed his WWI draft registration card on September 12, 1918 he listed his next of kin as "Vivie" Arnold, his wife. He also stated he was born January 17, 1880 in Route 7, Smithville, Dekalb, Tenn.

On the 1930 Federal census Thomas J Arnold is 50 years old, one year younger than his wife Vivian. They still have at home: Verona M (1908), Troy A (1910) and E Victor (1913). Verona and Victor are females, with beginning letter of their names "V" as is their mother's name.

Regardless, they all were buried at Heirs of Martha Pack cemetery, and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was present at their disinterment.
