

James S Palmer

James S Palmer was born in Tennessee about 1834, and died July 24, 1887 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. The identity of his parents is not known.

On September 15, 1859 he married Emiline Minerva Dyer, daughter of John Henry Dyer (1792-1844) and Mary P Youngblood (1796-1875). She was born January 15, 1838 at Silver Point in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died in 1886 in Putnam County, Tennessee.

James S Palmer fought for the Union in the Civil War. He was Commissary Sergeant for Company C, 1st Tennessee Mounted Infantry.

James and Emiline had eight known children: George M (1862), Luke Gilliam (1866), John Simpson (1869), John L (1869), Mary A (1871), Mary Ross (1872, Columbus (1874), and Martha Jane (1878).

James S Palmer was disinterred from Millie Dyer Palmer cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly Cemetery. His son, John L Palmer was present at the disinterment.
