



Jim Stewart

J B Stewart married Sophronia Johnson on July, 28, 1904. He is an enigma. She was the daughter of John D Johnson (1840-1914) and Hannah Pack (1839-1882). Saphronia was born April 1, 1859 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died August 6, 1905 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.

In 1880 she was “working for wages” in the home of Pennell and Nancy (Pack) Stewart. She must have met “Jim” here. Pennell Stewart (1808-1892) and Nancy Pack (1821-1908) had several children, but none named “J B” as their 1904 marriage states.

As they were married only a year no record of children was found.

Jim Stewart was interred at Heirs of Martha Pack cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at My Holly Cemetery. His sister-in-law, Mrs Mary Johnson was present at his disinterment.
