

John Puckett

John Puckett was born in Bottetourt County. Virginia on February 26, 1764 and died September 4, 1844. He was the son of Drury Puckett (1733-1794) of Virginia and Judith Roban (1737-1794) of Henrico County, Virginia.

On December 4, 1809 he married Rhoda Lyda in White County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Andrew Lyda (1740-1816) of Virginia and Sarah Mackey (1740-1807) of North Carolina. Rhoda was born in 1784 in North Carolina and died in 1843 in Smithville, Dekalb County, Tennessee.

John is one of two Revolutionary War soldiers at Mt Holly cemetery. He admitted he was never in a battle against the British, but was sent to Western Virginia to protect the settlers there from the depradations of the Indians.

Their children were: Mary (1811), Malinda (1813), Matilda (1813), George W (1814), Henry Lyda (1816), Marinda (1822), Prettyman (1824), John (1828) and Daniel (1832).

Both John and Rhoda were interred at D T Puckett cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. A grandson, Henry Puckett, was present at their disinterment.
