

Jossie (Smith) Love

Josephine Smith was born in 1885 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Alexander D Smith (1861-1926) and Mallie Parker (1860-?).

In 1902 she married John H Love, the son of Francis Marion Love (1844-1916) and Margaret J White (1848-1910). John H Love was born November 25, 1878 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died May 20, 1942.

Jossie had one sibling, her sister Lillie May (1891).

When John H Love registered for the draft in September of 1918 he declared Josie as his wife and stated "rit arm had ben brok in elbo and a little crockeed."

John and Josie had children Fannie M Love (1903), Era (1905), Willie Odell (1908) and Ballie (1910).

Jossie Love was interred in Moss Generation Cemetery, and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.
