



Lakie (Dunn) (Adamson) Johnson

Lakie Johnson was the second wife of Charles Allen Johnson. Her first husband was Joseph L Andamson (1786-1854) of Stokes, North Carolina, with whom she had six children. She then married Charles Allen Johnson on November 18, 1855 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Allen Johnson had also been married before, to Nancy Whitley who he married on January 12, 1811 in Davidson County, Tennessee.

Lakie Dunn was said to have been born in 1803 in Sweet Grass, Montana. This seems very unlikely since Lewis and Clark hadn't reached the Pacific as yet, and the Blackfoot Indians didn't like anyone trespassing on their property. More likely she was born in Tennessee, some say in 1790, some 1803, some say 1830. But all researchers agree she married Allen Johnson on November 18, 1855.

Allen Johnson was born about 1790 in Spartanburg, South Carolina. He was the son of John Johnson (1745-1828) and Mary Ward (1752-1820). Allen died in November, 1859 of pneumonia. The parents of Lakie Dunn are unknown. She died in June, 1862 in Smithville, Dekalb County, Tennessee.
