

Louella James

Louella James was born February 14, 1877 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died October 27, 1919. She was the daughter of John W James (1842-?) of Smithville, Dekalb County, Tennessee and Winnie Buck (1848-?) of North Carolina.

Her siblings recorded on the 1880 Federal Census were Malinda (1867), Mary E (1869), Wade (1871), Susan (1873), William Lee (1875), Louella (1877) and Joseph R (1879). Louella was 3 years old.

On the 1900 Federal Census Louella is still at home and is 23 years old, and is still single.

She is still home on the 1910 Federal Census, 33 years old and still single.

She probably never married since she died in 1919 before the next census was taken. Her maiden name is used on her monument.

She was buried at Maggie L Anderson cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.
