

Louisana (Atnip) Vanhooser
"LOUISA A. WIFE OF W C VANHOOSER"

Louisana Atnip was born November 1, 1862 in Smith County, Tennessee and died February 22, 1887 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of John Esau Atnip (1825-1901) of Smith County, Tennessee and Mary Clark (1831-1887) who died in Dekalb County, Tennessee.

On September 9, 1880 she married William Carroll Vanhooser in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was born April 24, 1860 in Warren County, Tennessee and died November 14, 1920 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the son of Sampson Vanhooser (1826-1863) of Warren County, Tennessee and Nancy Elizabeth Cantrell (1831-?). Sampson Vanhooser was killed in the Civil War. He was killed October 21, 1863.

Louisiana and William Carroll had two children; Mary Elizabeth (1882) and Zollie Coffer (1883). When Louisiana died in February 1887 he married Mary Cantrell in August of that year.

Louisiana Vanhooser was interred at Helen F Conger cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Her niece, Mrs L P Womack, was present at her disinterment.
