



Luvina (Tittsworth) Hale

Luvina Tittsworth was born April 3, 1863 and died September 30, 1894.

“A loving wife, a mother dear lies buried here.”

She was the daughter of Richard Murrell Tittsworth (1835-1893) and Mary Johnson (about 1856-?).

On July 24, 1888 she married Linton Hale (or Hailes) in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of William H Hailes (1820-1859) and Mary W Coggin (1823-?).

When Luvina died childless in 1894 Linton married Betty Johnson in 1897 and raised a large family.

Both Luvina and Linton were buried in Jeremiah Coggin Cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Noone was present at the disinterment.
