

Linda Murdock

Malinda Murdock was born in 1839. Her death date is unknown. She was a daughter of Samuel Murdock (1812-?) and Mary A Puckett (1811-1884).

In 1854 she and two of her sisters were admitted to the Tennessee School for the Deaf and Dumb, now known as the Tennessee School for the Deaf in Knoxville, Tennessee. Her sisters Amy (1839) and Luceta (1843) were admitted with her.

Malinda and Amy remained "old maids" but Luceta married Monroe Johnson.

Malinda Murdock was buried at D T Puckett cemetery and later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.
