

Mariah (Hayes) Pack

Mariah Hayes was born in 1817 in Warren County, Tennessee. Her date of death is not agreed to, as various researchers say she died in 1856 or 1870. Regardless, she was a daughter of Isaac Hayes (1767-1838) and Margaret Hayes (1799-1860).

In 1836 she married John Pack who was also a Warren Countian. He became Captain John Pack during the Civil War, being captain of Company I, 35th Tennessee Infantry Regiment. He was born about 1816 and died November 18, 1862 while serving in the Confederate Army.

John Pack was the son of Bartemus Pack (1795-1874) and Mary Bain (1796-?).

Their children were: William Matthew (1838), Mary J (1841), Margaret E (1843), Bartemus Hayes (1845), James Monroe (1848), Assenith Mariah (1850), Bethena (1854) and John Weddington (1856).

Captain John and Mariah were laid to rest in Heirs of Martha Pack Cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at the disinterment.
