



### **Marian Spencer**

**Moses Marian Spencer was born October 20, 1846 in Tennessee and died April 10, 1875 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the son of John Spencer (1813-1860) and Sarah Neal (1816-1900).**

**About 1865 he married Cinderella Turner, daughter of Henry L Turner (1800-1865) and Margaret Kelley (1816-1891). Cinderella was born in June, 1850 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died July 13, 1916 in Wichita Falls, Archer County, Texas.**

**Marian fought for the Union during the Civil War in Company A, 5<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Regiment. Also known as Stokes' Cavalry.**

**Marian and Cinderella had these children: Arbin (1866), John H (1868), Elizabeth (1870), Eva (1872), Josie (1876), Arthur (1877), Paralee (1882), and Dovie (1886).**

**The last three children were born after Marian's death date.**

**On April 8, 1887 Cinderella applied for Marian's Civil War pension.**

**Marian Spencer was disinterred from Ed Taylor cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. A granddaughter, Mrs C E McReynolds was present at the disinterment.**
