

Martha Ann (Glover) Clemons & John H Clemons

Martha Ann Glover was born in 1839 in Tennessee and died 1909 in Deedsville, Indiana. She was the daughter of Henry Glover, a shoemaker from North Carolina, and Mary?

John H Clemons was the son of William Clemons (1798-?) and Nancy (1798-?) of Virginia and he was born in either 1808, 1812, Jul 1813 or 1814, as these dates are found in various documents. His funeral marker states the year was 1808. He died in 1912.

John H Clemons married Martha Ann Glover on December 14, 1854. She was 26 years younger than John on every census until the 1880 census when she was recorded as being only 12 years younger.

On the 1910 census a landmark was reached. John was a widower in 1910, Martha having died in 1909. John was living with his youngest son Charley and his wife Minnie. John and Martha raised a large fanily: Ellen (1850), Elizabeth (1852), Shadrick (1856), Mary (1858), William (1860), Martha (1862) James (1863) Darthula (1864), Rufus (1865), Charley (1870), Clerry (1882) and Owen (1886).

Sometime before Martha's death she and John moved to Indiana to live with Charley and Minnie. They died there as their markers state near Logansport. They were apparently brought back to Dekalb County when Charley returned as they are now interred at Mt Holly.
