



Mary Elizabeth “Betty” (Cantrell) (Van Hooser) Womack

Mary Elizabeth “Betty” Cantrell was born September 9, 1869 in Liberty, Dekalb County, Tennessee. She died on June 2, 1948 in Huntsville, Madison Co., AL. She was a daughter of John Bethel Cantrell (1844-1878) and Virginia Atnip (1851-1912).

On August 7, 1887 she married William Carroll Van Hooser in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was born April 24, 1860 in Warren County, Tennessee and died March 14, 1920 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.

Their children were: John B (1888), James Stanton (1890), Nancy E (1893), Clara Lou (1900), William H (1900) and George Washington (1911).

On September 27, 1922 she married Lavender Pope Womack in DeKalb Co., TN. He was the son of John Womack (1832-bef. 1870) and Nancy Cameron (Sept. 6, 1824-Jan. 14, 1897 Tubb Cemetery). Pope was born Feb. 13, 1859 in DeKalb Co., TN and died January 11, 1945 in DeKalb Co., TN. He was buried in Smithville Cemetery. They had no children.

Both Mary Elizabeth and John Bethel were buried at Helen F Conger Cemetery, and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at the disinterment.
