



Mary Jane (Hallum) Carter

Mary Jane Hallum was born July 15, 1848 and died January 2, 1907. She was a daughter of John Thomas Hallum (1811-1899) and Frances Stensen (1817-1883).

On May 16, 1865 she married Samuel A Carter in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of George Washington Carter (1819-1899) of Virginia and Letitia Farmer (1821-1880). Samuel was born April 13, 1842 and died December 16, 1916.

They had several children: Samuel A (1867), William A (1866), Letty F (1870, the second wife of Green Moss), Sitty B (1872), Sarah F (1874), Elizabeth (1877), John T (1879), Melnee (1882) and Joseph E (1886).

They had nine children and raised them all to adulthood, an amazing feat for the times.

Mary Jane and Samuel were buried at Moss Generation Cemetery, and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Their oldest son, William A Carter was present at their disinterment.
