

Mary Jane (Stephens) Winfree

Mary Jane Stephens was born August 17, 1849 in Tennessee and died July 13, 1878 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of William G Stephens (1826-1889) and Charlotte Crickman (1840-1902).

She was the first wife of Horace Sullivin Winfrey, who she married June 25, 1867 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was born July 2, 1847 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died March 10, 1938 on Mountain Creek in Warren County, Tennessee. He was a son of Benjamin Franklin Winfree (1814-1883) of Halifax County, Virginia and Juda Robinson (1818-1903).

Mary Jane and Horace had four children who were William Franklin (1868), Fannie Elizabeth (1870), Ida Nancy (1873) and Robert Solon (1875). She outlived them all.

Mary Jane Winfree was interred at Winfree/ J W Winnard cemetery along with Horace Sullivin Winfree, her son Solon, her daughters Fannie and Ida, and her father-in-law and mother-in-law, Ben Franklin Winfree and Juda Robinson.

They were all disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Mary Janes sister, Miranda Christian and Horace Winfree's second wife, May Josephine Brock were present at the disinterment.
