



Mary Jane (Winfree) Dunn

Mary Jane Winfree was born May 14, 1887 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died June 9, 1911. She was the daughter of Horace Sullivan Winfree (1847-1938) and Mary Josephine Brock (1849-1944).

On April 28, 1902 in Exum, Dekalb County, Tennessee she married James Dunn. He was born between 1870 and 1890 and was murdered in Dekalb County, Tennessee in 1910. His burial site- if he had one- is unknown.

Mary's first child did not survive. It died December 23, 1902. Her second was Fannie Elizabeth (1904), who was born in Nashville, Tennessee and died May 6, 1975 in Cannon County, Tennessee.

Mary Jane succumbed to tuberculosis on June 9, 1911. She was interred in an unknown place and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery.
