

Richard McGinnis Trapp

Richard McGinnis Trapp was born October 26, 1846 in Temperance Hall, Dekalb County, Tennessee and died November 5, 1899 in Temperance Hall, Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of John Trapp (1809-1881) of White County, Tennessee and Susan McGinnis (1814-about 1881).

On January 27, 1884 he married Martha Terry in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of William Franklin Terry (1825-1863) and Harriet Caroline Turner (1832-1894). Martha Terry was born May 25, 1856 and died October 3, 1908.

Martha and Richard had three children: James F (1885), Elizabeth A (1889) and Lillie Jewel (1899).

Richard Trapp was interred at Minnie Trapp cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. His daughter, Lillie Jewel was present at his disinterment.
