



**Ruby Jones**

**“She was the sunshine of our home.”**

**Ruby Jones was born March 2, 1907 near Lancaster, DeKalb Co., TN and died January 7, 1926 in West Frankfort, Franklin Co., IL. She was the daughter of William E Jones (April 1877 TN-?) of Illinois and Dovie Beulah Jones (1882-1908) of Tennessee.**

**Ruby Jones died in her 19<sup>th</sup> year, and was not married. She had a sister, Wilmettie Jones (1900-1900), also buried in Mount Holly Cemetery. On the 1920 U S Federal Census her half- brother Willie O (1914) and half-sisters Laura B (1912) and Johnnie (1917) were recorded. Also living with the Jones family was Ruby's grandmother, Tennie (1848-1924) who was also mother of Dovie Beulah Jones. William E Jones had married his second wife, Cora Gleason, September 29, 1908 in DeKalb Co., TN.**

**Ruby Jones was buried at T A Starnes cemetery and later relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.**
