

Sallie Watts

Sallie Watts was born in January/February 1917 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She died August 8, 1925 in DeKalb Co., TN. She was a daughter of William Calvin Watts (1883-1964) and Lou Carter (1880-1957).

She had siblings Vester A (1903), Robert F (1909), Hooper (1913), Dimple C (1920) and Lonnie (1923).

Her father, William Calvin, stated on his Draft Registration card that they were living at Silver Point in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He named Lou Watts as his wife and declared he had three broken ribs. He registered on his birthdate, September 12. It was his 35th birthday.

She was buried at S E Anderson Cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Noone was listed as present at her disinterment.
