

Sarah H Glenn

Sarah Hatton Glenn was born March 14, 1861. She was the daughter of John Glenn and Jane Mauldon.

On February 8, 1880 she married Dr Samuel Walker in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of Hampton Walker (1811-1886) and Mary Hicks (1813-?), and he was born in Warren County, Tennessee February 8, 1848 and died February 3, 1899. In 1875 he became Dr Samuel Walker. He began practicing medicine in Dekalb County, Tennessee in 1878.

Dr Walker and Sarah had nine children: Laura (1882) died an infant, Claude (1883), Mollie (1884), Sammie (1887), Clarence (1890), Sterling (1892), Nalma (1894), Martha (1896), and John (1898).

She was almost 20 years younger than Dr Walker, and when he died in 1899 she was only 39 years old.

She was disinterred from Ed Taylor cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was present at the disinterment.
