



**Sarah (Brown) Puckett**

**Sarah Brown was born December 4, 1832, but her date of death is not known. She was the daughter of John Walker Brown (1811-1880) of Virginia and Elizabeth Anderson (1813-1880) of Tennessee.**

**On March 12, 1874 she married Henry Lyda Puckett, son of Revolutionary War soldier John Puckett (1764-1844) of Botetourt County, Virginia and Rhoda Lyda (1784-1885) of North Carolina. Henry Lyda Puckett was born October 15, 1816 in White County, Tennessee and died October 25, 1885 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.**

**Henry Puckett had married twice before he wed Sarah Brown. He first married Margaret Love (1821-1854) on September 10, 1840 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. They reared five children: Sylvanus (1841), Perry M (1846), Martha (1849) and Hezekiah Carr (1851). Margaret died in 1854.**

**Henry then married Anna J Null (1830-1874) on March 13, 1856 and they added five more children to the household. They were: Joel (1857), Mary Jane (1859), Henry Cherry (1861), Amanda (1865) and Luther Race (1867).**

**He then married Sarah Brown with whom no more children were born. Sarah was 17 years younger than Henry Lyda.**

**She was interred at D T Puckett cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.**
