

Sarah (Brown) Puckett

Sarah Brown was born December 4, 1832, but her date of death is not known. She was the daughter of John Walker Brown (1811-1880) of Virginia and Elizabeth Anderson (1813-1880) of Tennessee.

On March 12, 1874 she married Henry Lyda Puckett, son of Revolutionary War soldier John Puckett (1764-1844) of Botetourt County, Virginia and Rhoda Lyda (1784-1885) of North Carolina. Henry Lyda Puckett was born October 15, 1816 in White County, Tennessee and died October 25, 1885 in Dekalb County, Tennessee.

Henry Puckett had married twice before he wed Sarah Brown. He first married Margaret Love (1821-1854) on September 10, 1840 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. They reared five children: Sylvanus (1841), Perry M (1846), Martha (1849) and Hezekiah Carr (1851). Margarett died in 1854.

Henry then married Anna J Null (1830-1874) on March 13, 1856 and they added five more children to the household. They were: Joel (1857), Mary Jane (1859), Henry Cherry (1861), Amanda (1865) and Luther Race (1867).

He then married Sarah Brown with whom no more children were born. Sarah was 17 years younger than Henry Lyda.

She was interred at D T Puckett cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at her disinterment.
