

Silas Wright Watson

Silas Wright Watson was born July 30, 1850 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died December 12, 1895 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the firstborn son of Allen Watson (1809-1885) of North Carolina and Margaret Bates (1821-1900) of Tennessee.

On October 5, 1876 he married Ethelda D Helms in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Coleman Helms (1823-?) and Mary B ? (about 1832-?) of North Carolina. Sometime before 1870 they moved to Dekalb County, Tennessee.

Silas was sickly, and often bedridden. He was appointed Postmaster of Exum, a small community in Dekalb County.

When Silas died in 1895 Ethelda married James Judkins in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She died the following year, in 1897.

Silas and Ethelda had four children: Alonzo (1878), Herschel (1888), S D (1896) and S E (1896), the last two possibly twins.

Ethelda and Silas Wright were interred at Alpha Watson cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Their son Herschel Watson was present at the disinterment.
