



**Telitha (Campbell) Johnson**  
**"AGE 67 yrs 2 ms & 11 dys"**

**"Tho lost to sight, to memory dear."**

**Telitha Campbell was born January 26, 1813 and died May 7, 1880 in Smithville, Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was a daughter of Allen Campbell (about 1790-?) and Elizabeth Gilbert (1792-1829) of Kentucky. The 1880 Federal Census Mortality Schedules states that she died of**

**“Dropsy” at age 66.**

**In 1838 she married John Johnson. He was a son of Charles Allen Johnson (1790-1880) of South Carolina and Nancy Adeline Whiteley (1793-1854) of Virginia. John Johnson was born July 19, 1812 in Warren County, Tennessee and died March 2, 1893.**

**When Civil War came John went back to his home county and joined the 35<sup>th</sup> Tennessee Infantry, CSA. He survived the war and drew a pension.**

**Their rather large number of children were: Susan (1839), James W (1841), William A (1843), Nancy A (1844), John T (1847), George (1850), Campbell (1850) and Sarah E (1852).**

**Telitha and John were relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Their original burial place was not recorded. Noone was listed as being present at their disinterment.**
