



Tennie (Price) Jones

It seems possible that almost nothing is correct on this monument. Without a long discussion, there are a lot of major discrepancies between what is on this monument and all the existing records. Her husband is on the other side of the monument, and the same is his situation.

Mary Tennessee Price was born in 1843, according to the 1850 census in difference with the 1848 date on her monument (June by the 1900 census), in White County, Tennessee and died in 1924 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Hopefully the 1850 census did not mistake a two-year-old for a seven-year-old. No death certificate found in TN for her. She was the daughter of Llewellyn Price (1820-1844) of Tennessee and Jane G Maudlin (1818-1897) of North Carolina. Jane remarried to John B. Glenn by 1850, which was where she and "Mary T" were in White Co., TN.

On November 7, 1862 Tennie married William E Jones in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was born August 3, 1842 according to his monument (1900 census states August also) [or Sept. 13?] in Smith County, Tennessee, but it seems his correct birth year might be about 1840 according to the 1850 and later censuses, and he died May 7, 1904 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the son of William H Jones (1804-1880) of Blount County, Tennessee and Elizabeth Exum (1808-1851) of Dekalb County, Tennessee. William E Jones was a grandson of Prettyman Jones (1772-

1826).

Their only child was Dovie Beulah Jones (1882-1908).

Mary and William were buried at T A Starnes cemetery and were later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as being present at their disinterment.
