



Thurman C Martin

Thurman C Martin was born September 20, 1894 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died October 24, 1921. He was a son of Edmund C Martin (1853-?) and Mary Roxana Coggins (1866-1906).

His siblings were: Luther T (1883), Mary E (1885), Lella B (1888), Harvey A (1891), and Ova (1898).

In 1917 when he registered for the draft he declared he was single, and was living and working for his brother-in-law, James W Smith. Smith had married Martin's sister Lella.

Smith's farm was located at Silver Point in Dekalb County. Tuberculosis was common there.

“A friend to his country and a believer in Christ.”

He was disinterred from Ina Greer cemetery and relocated to Mt Holly cemetery.
